Criteria to Apply

To claim Carer's Allowance the cared-for person has to be claiming specific benefits throughout the award length.

Additionally, the carer who wishes to claim Carer's Allowance has to meet the eligibility criteria. It is important to note that claiming this benefit can alter the benefits received by the cared-for person and the carer.

Here are some of the main criteria:

- The carer is over 16 years of age
- The carer is not studying more than 21 hours a week
- The carer does not earn over £128 a week after Tax. National Insurance and expenses.
- Care is provided for at least 35 hours per week
